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## **POLICE REPORT**

**PURCELLVILLE, Va. November 3, 2016 -**

10/28/2016 - 08:18p.m. 200 Blk. Hackley Ct. **Domestic Dispute**

Police were called to the scene for a neighborhood report of people yelling in the parking lot. It was determined to be an argument between a boyfriend and girlfriend. One of the parties had left the scene prior to police arriving on the scene. The party on scene said that no assault(s) took place.

10/28/2016 – 09:30p.m. 100 Blk. Purcellville Gateway Dr. **Counterfeit Money**

A store clerk received a \$10 bill that appeared to be counterfeit. The fake bill was taken into custody and will be turned over to the U.S. Secret Service for investigation.

The victim was assaulted by an acquaintance over a prior dispute between the two. On police arrival, the suspect had fled the scene. The victim was not injured and the incident is under investigation and charges are pending.

Police were called back to the scene of a domestic situation that had occurred earlier. One of the parties had returned and assaulted family members. Tyree Smith, a 38 year old male of Purcellville, was arrested for domestic assault and being drunk in public. He was transported to the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center and held. The victims were not seriously injured.
