POLICE REPORT

PURCELLVILLE, Va. December 1, 2016 -

11/23/2016 - 08:30p.m. 100 Blk. E. Main St. **Traffic Stop**

Police Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation. It was determined that the person had consumed alcohol and he presented the officer with a fraudulent I.D. The incident is under investigation and charges are pending.

Police were called to the scene of person that was having a mental health crisis. The person was calmed down and appropriate mental health resources were provided to the individual.
