## REMINDERS:

- Governor Northam extended the expiration of Executive Order 53 until May 8<sup>th</sup>, continuing the closure of non-essential businesses and services by an additional two weeks
- Executive Order 55, directing residents to “stay home” except for essential errands is still in effect through June 10<sup>th</sup>
  - \*No groups of 10 or more, public or private, except those living within the same household
- CDC recommends individuals wear cloth face covering over nose and mouth when in public
  - \*Please reserve N95 and surgical masks for first responders, hospitals & critical workers
