




# CORONAVIRUS INFO

**MAY 7, 2020**

## REMINDERS:

- Governor Northam extended the expiration of provisions of Executive Order 53 until **May 14<sup>th</sup>**, continuing the closure of non-essential businesses and services by an additional week, such as hair salons and barber shops.
- Executive Order 55, directing residents to “stay home” except for essential errands and banning gatherings of 10 or more is still in effect through June 10<sup>th</sup>
- Governor Northam hopes VA will enter Phase I of reopening, easing some restrictions on businesses and gathering within the next few weeks, providing health data supports it
- Town of Purcellville has extended the real and personal property tax due date from June 5<sup>th</sup> to **June 22<sup>nd</sup>**

\*Water Dept. recommends residents and businesses conduct weekly water flushing of unoccupied buildings to avoid water stagnation and possible growth of harmful bacteria.



\*Two (2) \$10 vouchers have been mailed to Purcellville utility account holders to encourage local business patronage. Vouchers can be redeemed at participating Town businesses listed at [www.purcellvilleva.gov/voucherprogram](http://www.purcellvilleva.gov/voucherprogram). Vouchers are valid through 12/31/20. Businesses can still register for inclusion in the Town voucher program, but must visit the website above to complete an application.

### Public Works:

- \*Vacant buildings- flush water after non-usage period
- \*No flushing of disposable wipes to ensure health of the sewer system
