REMINDERS:

- Governor Northam issued Executive Order 62, delaying the entrance of the Northern Virginia Region into Phase One of reopening until May 29th, to allow more time for health metrics in our area to improve
- Executive Order 62 keeps existing restrictions in place such as only essential businesses are allowed open, gatherings of more than 10 people are prohibited, social distancing must be observed, and the wearing of cloth face masks is encouraged
- VA Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) sites are still closed in our area, but the validity of driver and vehicle credentials has been extended, visit www.dmv.virginia.gov for details
