## REMINDERS:

- Purcellville enters Phase Two of reopening under Governor Northam’s amended [Executive Order 65](#) this **Friday, June 12, 2020**.
- Executive Order 65 allows for 50% capacity of indoor dining at restaurants, 30% occupancy of indoor fitness facilities, reopening of pools for exercise (with restrictions) , and public and private indoor gatherings of up to 50 individuals. Please refer to the full text of [Order 65](#) as well as the specific [Business Sector](#) guidelines for questions.
- Wearing of a face covering while inside public buildings, as well as some other businesses, is still required under guidelines provided in [Executive Order 63](#).
- VA Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) has expanded its extension of the validity of vehicle credentials & corresponding emissions inspections, visit [www.dmv.virginia.gov](http://www.dmv.virginia.gov) for details.
