REMINDERS:

- Purcellville has entered Phase 3 under reopening guidelines outlined in [Executive Order 67](#). Gatherings of up to 250 people are allowed and specific [Business Sector Guidelines](#) are provided for assistance. Operations under Phase 3 include including the removal of restaurant and non-essential retail business occupancy caps, bar seating must remained closed, entertainment venues may open at 50% capacity, and pools and gyms may open at 75% capacity. Social distancing and disinfecting measures are still in place for each business sector.
- Wearing of a face covering while inside public buildings, as well as some other businesses, is still required under guidelines provided in [Executive Order 63](#).

*Town of Purcellville’s annual Independence Day Parade will take place **Saturday, July 4th at noon**. The parade will be vehicle-only due to current coronavirus limitations. Spectators must adhere to social distancing of a minimum of six feet from non-family/household parade watchers along the route, and must not gather in groups larger than 250. The parade will begin at Loudoun Valley HS on N. Maple Ave, turn right on Main St, then left on Nursery Ave, continuing on until Emerick ES.
